## Home Learning

## Absences

### *Unexcused Absence*

In the event of an unexcused absence, any missed assignments or exams will receive a "Z" as the academic grade.

### *Excused Absence*

In the event of an excused absence, a student has 3 days to make-up any missed assignments or exams. After three days, the assignment or exam will remain as a "Z".

## Remind App

All students are required to download and sign up on the app Remind. This app is free and is utilized for important information. The class code will be provided on the first day of class. Parents are highly encouraged to sign up as well.

## Academic Honesty
